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AUMSVILLE CITY COUNCIL Special meeting Minutes – March 16, 2019

Mayor Clevenger called the meeting to order at 12:00 PM in the Chester Bridges Memorial Community Center, 555 Main Street, Aumsville, Oregon. Council present was: Councilors Gus Bedwell, Nico Casarez, Jim Case, Larry Purdy, and Della Seney. City Administrator Ron Harding (CA Harding), was also present. Angelica Ceja arrived at 2.10 PM

CA Harding led council through a discussion about the city mission statement. The council by consensus agreed the mission statement still represents an overall mission and no changes were recommended. The mission statement to read as follows:

"The City of Aumsville is the foundation, partnering with residents and businesses, to provide a great place to live".

The council then focused on the city goals. The City of Aumsville will:

- 1. Provide and maintain municipal facilities and infrastructure to support current operations and growth.
- 2. Support and encourage community involvement to create a sense of community and enhance livability.
- 3. Create an environment to attract, retain and grow businesses.
- 4. Ensure a safe and prepared environment for citizens and businesses.
- 5. Provide City services that are responsive to citizens, communicate effectively, and demonstrate good stewardship.

Council wanted the goals to reflect current situations within the city to wordsmith a number of the flowing goals. Changes included 1.3 to include action words, 2.4 regarding public health and safety, 2.6 form into action to obtain verses explore, and 5.3 to explore effective communication methods.
