AUMSVILLE CITY COUNCIL MEETING Minutes

March 27, 2017

Corrected at 4/24/17 ACC Mtg.

Mayor Baugh called the meeting to order at 7:02 PM in the Chester Bridges Memorial Community Center, 555 Main Street, Aumsville, Oregon.

Council present were Mayor Robert Baugh, Jr., Councilors Brian Czarnik, Della Seney, Lorie Walters, Councilor Trina Lee, Gabe Clayton and Councilor Kevin Crawford. City Administrator Ron Harding (CA Harding), Administrative Assistant Lora Hofmann (AA Hofmann) and City Clerk Colleen Rogers (CC Rogers) were also present.

Mayor Baugh called the Public Hearing to Order at 7:03PM to consider an amendment to the Development Ordinance:

- Section 1.00 Definitions: Marijuana Processor, Marijuana Producer, Marijuana-Related Use(s), Marijuana Testing Laboratory, Marijuana Retailer, Marijuana Wholesaler;
- Section 8.00 I Industrial. Marijuana-related uses
- Section 22.00 Supplementary Zone Regulations: Marijuana-related uses

The Opening Statement was read into record. There being no declaration of interest council moved on to the Staff Report. Council received a letter of recommendation from Aumsville Planning Commission and AA Hofmann presented the staff report. There was no proponent, opponent, or general testimony.

Mayor Baugh Closed the Public Hearing at 7:17 PM

After council deliberations <u>Councilor Lee made a motion to accept and adopt the Aumsville</u> <u>Planning Commission recommendations and Councilor Seney seconded; Voting in favor of</u> <u>the motion were Councilors Clayton, Crawford, Czarnik, Lee, **Seney,** Walters and Mayor <u>Baugh. The motion passed unanimously.</u></u>

ORDINANCES: Council considered ORD. NO. 651; AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 323, THE DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE (regarding marijuana). Council consensus was to read the ordinance by title only. <u>Councilor Czarnik made a motion to approve the first reading of Ordinance No. 651 by title only and Councilor Lee seconded; Voting in favor of the motion were Councilors Clayton, Crawford, Czarnik, Lee, **Seney**,</u>

Walters and Mayor Baugh. the motion passed unanimously.

<u>Councilor Lee made a motion to approve the second reading of Ordinance 651 by title</u> only and Councilor Seney seconded. Voting in favor of the motion were Councilors Clayton, Crawford, Czarnik, Lee, **Seney**, Walters and Mayor Baugh. The motion passed unanimously.

Councilor Czarnik moved to adopt Ordinance No. 651 Councilor Crawford seconded. Voting in favor of the motion were Councilors Clayton, Crawford Czarnik, Lee, **Seney**, Walters and Mayor Baugh. The motion passed unanimously.

CONSENT AGENDA: Council reviewed the March 13, 2017 through March 15, 2017 Check Registers and the March 13, 2017 Aumsville City Council Meeting Minutes. <u>Councilor</u> <u>Seney made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda as presented. Councilor Czarnik</u> <u>seconded the motion. Voting for the motion were Councilors Clayton, Crawford, Czarnik,</u> <u>Seney, Walters and Mayor Baugh. Councilor Lee abstained. The motion carried.</u>

COUNCIL GOALS CONTINUED:

Council continued with their goal setting process that was started at their retreat in February with facilitator Nancy Boyer from Mid-Valley Council of Government. She gave a recap of the previous workshop and gave an overview of outline for this session.

The group discussed their goals and objectives for the city's infrastructure, community enhancement and involvement, business friendly environment, safe environment for citizens/businesses, and responsive city services that demonstrate good stewardship.

Facilitator Boyer will compile the council goals and objectives as they have been discussed; then bring it back to council at a future meeting. She stated that the next steps for council will be to start thinking about their priorities.

OTHER BUSINESS: Councilor Crawford announced that he will not be at the April 10th ACC Meeting. Councilor Lee reminded everyone of the April 18th filing deadline to file their SEI report.

The meeting adjourned at 9:12 PM without objection.
