

Aumsville September 2021 Monthly Police Report

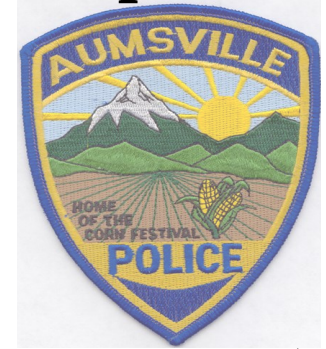
DEPARTMENT MESSAGE:

The reserves worked a total of 110 hours during the month of September 106 volunteer hours and 4 paid hours.

September brought the return of school and children walking to school. As such we have had 3 Pedestrian Crossing Enforcements, where we issued 13 citations for drivers failing to stop and remain stop while pedestrians were crossing or attempting to cross the road. If you see someone crossing the road at an intersection, not only is it polite to stop, it's the law.

Also, as our weather turns colder and the rain starts to fall, the roadway will become slick from all the oils and debris that was collected during the summer. Leave yourselves ample room to stop and maneuver around possible obstacles.
