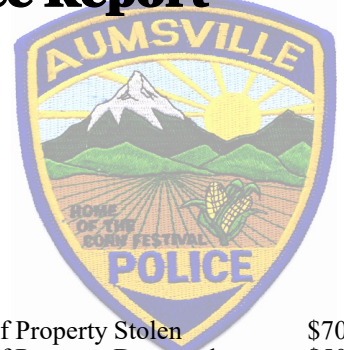


City of Aumsville April 2022 Monthly Police Report
