

SUGGESTIONS FOR POLITICAL SIGNS

We hope your upcoming campaign goes well. The information that follows is provided to assist you in conducting your campaign.

The intent of the city is to allow advertisement without undue difficulty; to promote attractive signs that do not impede pedestrian and vehicular traffic and are pleasant with their surroundings; and to reduce the number of unneeded signs.



May we suggest you:

1. Obtain the consent of the person who is responsible for the property where you are locating the sign.
2. Remove the signs no later than the fourth day following the election.
3. Designate a person who will be responsible for the property maintenance of each sign and their removal after the election.
4. Indicate on the sign the name and telephone number of someone to call if the sign is in need of repair, is weather beaten or needs to be removed.
5. No sign, other than approved governmental signs, shall be placed upon any street or highway right of way. This includes telephone poles.

We know you share with us a desire to adhere to these suggestions that will make your campaign signs more effective, will lessen criticism of your political signs, and will maintain the neat and attractive appearance of your community.
