
FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

What is an accessory structure?

A detached, subordinate building, the use of which is incidental to the main building or use of the land. An accessory structure does not include habitable living space.

Is a tiny house considered an accessory structure?

No, an accessory structure does not include habitable living space. All accessory structures should not have electricity or running water. Contact Aumsville City Hall for more information on these types of structures.

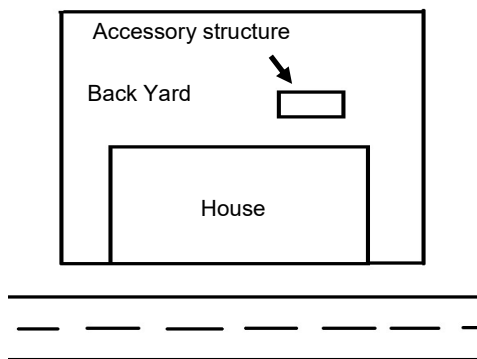
Residential Accessory Structures

Type A Permit Required

Type A Permit requirements:

- Under 200 square feet and less than 10 feet tall at the highest point
- Must be in back yard
- Minimum set back of 3 feet from side and rear lot lines, measured from wall closest to property line
- Decks/patios less than 30 inches off the ground
- Deck/patio covers are less than 200 square feet and less than 10 f tall at the midline of the roof
- Any fence or shed

Call Public Works before starting the process to confirm location or for any questions. This service is free to residents. 503-749-1185

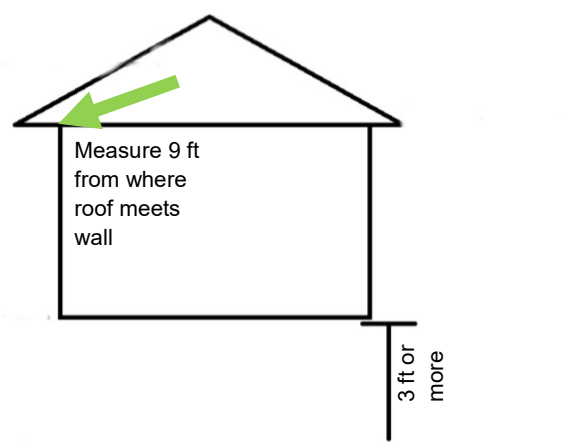


Residential Accessory Structures, Marion County

Building Permit Required (may be in addition to Type A)

Structures need a building permit and/or a site development review if any of these apply:

- Accessory structure has a footprint larger than 200 square feet with a maximum height of 16 feet
- The deck is more than 30 inches off the ground
- Additions or alterations which make changes to the structure, including garage conversions
- Complete re-roof down to the sheeting/rafters



Commercial/Industrial Accessory Structures

Additions and Alterations

Any and all additions and alterations of commercial property are required to have a building permit PRIOR to work commencing.
