

ORDINANCE NO. 96

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A SEAL FOR THE CITY OF AUMSVILLE; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF THE TOWN OF AUMSVILLE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The city of Aumsville ordains as follows:

Section 1. The corporate seal of the city of Aumsville shall consist of an outer rim on which shall be the words:

“Seal of the City of Aumsville, Marion County, Oregon, 1911”
within which shall appear in appropriate design the Coat of Arms of the State of Oregon. The impression of the seal shall not exceed two inches in diameter.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 2 of the town of Aumsville, Oregon, is repealed.

Section 3. Whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the city of Aumsville that this ordinance become effective at the earliest possible date after enactment and approval thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by unanimous vote of the members of the council present and its approval by the mayor.

PASSED and unanimously adopted by the council of the city of Aumsville and signed by the mayor this 6th day of May, 1964.
