

ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TOWN BASE OR PLANE OF REFERENCES FOR ELEVATIONS AND FIXING THE ELEVATION OF THE PRIMAL BENCH MARK.

Be it ordained by the common council of the town of Aumsville, Oregon:

Section 1. That the upper surface of the babbit plug placed in a large stone located in the parking at the northeast corner of the intersection of Seventh and Main Streets has been ascertained to be and is hereby established at 75.64 feet above the base of grades for the city of Aumsville, Oregon, and in the execution of all field work, maps, profiles, etc. the same shall be executed, graded and relatively referred to the aforesaid primal bench mark.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after its approval by the mayor, as an emergency exists inasmuch as improvements for the town of Aumsville are needed immediately for the safety of its inhabitants.
